







 The wear guard (S56459) in between the IP Boot and the C2 shank may wear over time and cause damage to the IP boot if not checked regularly.

 Use the following procedure to replace wear guards as needed.







- The wear plate may need to be replaced after a number of acres, this is highlighted in the picture on the right.
- Use 9/16" wrenches to remove the 3/8" bolts.

 Once the bolts have been removed, pull the boot back and remove the wear guard.

• Insert the new wear guard, ensuring the locating dowel in the boot fits securely into the locating notch of the opener.







STEP 3 CONTINUED

- Insert the new wear guard, ensuring the locating dowel in the boot fits securely into the locating notch of the opener.
- It should fit similarly to the picture shown here:









- Once in place, insert the bolts and snug up the lock nuts.
- You may also consider using blue thread lock.
